Aims & Scope

Sociocultural Pragmatics (PrSC) seeks to encourage the dissemination of research results on theoretical and applied Pragmatics with an emphasis on social and cultural aspects of the Spanish language in all its forms and expressions. *PrSC* publishes

materials that investigate theoretical notions that are useful to establish the interdependence between pragmatic, social and cultural aspects of Spanish. Manuscripts are welcome with thematic, theoretical, empirical and terminological initiatives within the area of pragmatics, sociopragmatics and sociocultural pragmatics of the Spanish language. *PrSC* promotes in particular the study of language use from the user perspective and within their sociocultural community. *PrSC* accepts original articles preferably written in Spanish, but will be considered for acceptance articles written in other Romance languages and English.
